This is a terrific opportunity to expand and improve your leadership skills while being mentored by the professional CTW theatrical staff. *A stipend of \$150 will be included in this role.*

Applicants must be a sophomore, junior or senior. All applicants will be considered on their merits, with preference for juniors and seniors who have been in CTW productions.

We offer three potential opportunities for student directors, depending on the needs of the production:

- Music
- Directing/Acting
- Dance

Responsibilities include:

- Attending CTW rehearsals as available (Tuesdays and Thursdays 4-8, and Saturdays 10am-2pm) We require 8 hours minimum for a comprehensive experience.
- Becoming familiar with the script and music
- Working with performers to warm up actors and practice scenes, teach music and choreography as requested by the directors
- Taking notes or marking script/score as requested by the directors
- Supporting producers with tasks as needed and time allows.

The ideal student director will enjoy working with children, be highly motivated, interested in learning and willing to step in, as needed. Initiative is invited and encouraged!
